Job Position: Nursery-Preschool Teacher
Department: Kid's Ministry

Commitment: 8 hours per week

Job Scope:

Provide assistance to the Nursery-Preschool Coordinator and the Redeemer Kids Director in the Nursery-Preschool classes by implementing classroom policies, being a consistent teacher on Sunday mornings, and building Christ-centered relationships with families, kids, and volunteers. Time will be split: 5 hours on Sunday morning and 3 hours during the week.

Duties & Responsibilities:

Develop loving community

- Pray for children and ministry
- Establish relationships with children, families, and volunteers by sharing stories on how children are growing in their faith and how God is working in your life
- Keep accountability with coordinator and attend monthly kids' ministry staff meeting

Be a Consistent Leadership Presence on Sunday Mornings (5 hours/weekly)

- Arrive by 7:15am to ensure set up is ready to receive children before service begins
- Keep a checklist of set up and clean up handy for volunteers to follow
- Join Team Huddle meetings (7:45) with Kids Staff to go over Sunday agenda and pray
- Connect with volunteers before families arrive to run through lesson plan/materials
- Greet families and warmly welcome children as they arrive
- Provide Biblical instruction with Bible stories, songs, and lesson related activities
- Maintain a safe, clean and orderly classroom; Keep toys and supplies organized
- Check in with volunteers and Coordinator at the end of service and follow up on any issues that arose during service

Provide Assistance and Support for Special Events

- Flexibility in collaboration and support of various ministry programs/camps

Requirements/Skills

- Experience (1+years) working with nursery/preschool children
- Appropriate educational background and/or experience
- Knowledge of and willingness to learn the culture of the church and non-profit entity
- A growing relationship with Christ

- Ability to work under minimal supervision with volunteer and staff teams
- Ability to interact with parents/volunteers/staff associates at all levels
- A willingness to be a team player
- An energetic and cooperative spirit
- Excellent communication skills
