10 ways you can pray for and show the love of Christ to children/teens in your life:

- 1. Think of specific students in your life to pray for and use the Student Ministry Theme verses, Ephesians 3:14-21, as a guide for your prayer.*
- 2. Make a list of the children and students in your neighborhood, and begin praying for them on a regular basis. (If you don't know their names, this would be a great time to connect with them and their families.)*
- 3. Connect with parents of children and teens in your neighborhood. Ask the parents how the balance of distance learning, work life, family life, etc. is going? How do they feel? How does their teen feel about everything? Ask them if there are specific ways you can support or pray for them.*
- 4. If you are comfortable, host a gathering for your students or students in your neighborhood. Provide prepackaged snacks, board games, a space to connect, etc.*
- 5. Write an encouraging postcard (for visibility with parents), encouraging the teens in your neighborhood.*
- 6. Make an At Home Study Goody Bag for kids in your neighborhood with prepackaged snacks. Include an encouraging note.*
- 7. Request to join our Parent Facebook Group at Redeemer for online support and community.*
- 8. Check out our ministry partnership with AXIS, a resource concerning teen culture and the gospel, and educate yourself on teen culture today. (Use the password: "Redeemer" for full access).*
- 9. Host a Redeemer small group at your home.*
