

Important June Regathering Announcement

Dear Redeemer Family and Friends,

As you may know, the State of California has begun to lift restrictions that were instituted last year to face the COVID-19 pandemic in response to the new CDC guidelines. Those changes, made in light of growing vaccination and decreasing illness rates, are soon to be in effect.

It has been Redeemer's goal to respond to the challenges of this season in a God-honoring way and to respect our governing authorities and members of our church. In doing so, we are excited to welcome back many in our congregation and be good neighbors to all who wish to worship with us on campus and online. To that end, we have decided to make the following changes to our policies and procedures beginning on **Sunday, June 13**.

- **Pre-registration:** Registration for Sunday morning church services will be discontinued beginning on Sunday, June 13. You will no longer be required to register your attendance before attending in-person for our 3 services (8:15am, 9:45am, 11:15am).
- **Masks:** Face coverings will be optional on our campus on Sunday mornings for our indoor and outdoor services, as well as Kids and Student ministries. While worshipping together as a church family, we encourage people to be mindful of seating, knowing that people have different comfort levels when it comes to safe, social distancing
- **Online Services:** Our weekly Livestream will continue to be available each week at 9:45 am for your viewing and engagement. We are incredibly thankful to be able to offer online services each Sunday, and we thank our online family for joining us!

As we enter into this next stage of regathering, we know that Sunday mornings on campus will consist of some church family members who will be wearing masks and some who will not. I want to remind us all that this health crisis has affected each of us uniquely. In the gospel, let us honor the personal decisions and needs of others with kindness and gentleness. Let us uplift and serve one another. Let us pursue the unity of

the Spirit in the bond of peace. As I preached this past Sunday, let us not seek our own self-interests, but that of Jesus Christ (Philippians 2:21)!
