Redeemer is a gospel-centered, outward-facing, multiethnic, intergenerational church.



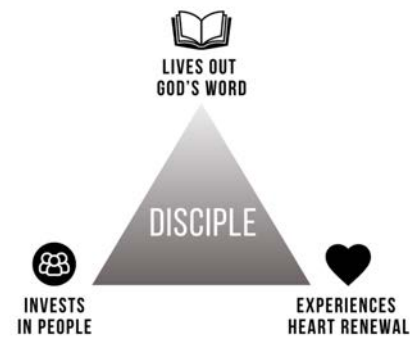
