

# HOW TO USE THIS GUIDE

We are excited for you to journey with us through the New Testament this year. A daily rhythm of being in the Word is essential for our spiritual formation in Christ. Scripture is both beautiful, as it points us to the sweetness of Jesus, and useful, as it equips us to live out our faith.

As you journey with us, we encourage you to find a consistent time and space to spend 10-15 minutes each day with the Lord. Each week there is a verse from the readings we encourage you to reflect on and memorize. As you read, consider the questions below.

## OBSERVING

As you read, note your observations of the text. Highlight or underline key words or repeated themes. Consider asking and answering the following questions:

- What does this passage teach me about God?
- What does this passage show me about people?
- How does this passage point me to Jesus & His Gospel?

## APPLYING

God's Word exposes our need for the Gospel (Guilt), God's faithfulness to provide for us in the Gospel (Grace), and shapes how we are to live in light of the Gospel (Gratitude). Take some time to consider how the passage shows us these three things by answering the questions below:

- Guilt: How does this passage challenge or convict me?
- Grace: What grace or encouragement does this passage offer? What Gospel truths can I hold onto today from this text?
- Gratitude: How should this passage shape my worship or gratitude to God? How can this passage guide me to live out the gospel in my relationships and community?

## PRAYING

Allow the Scriptures to shape and align your heart with His Gospel through praying His Word. Allow God's Word to fuel your prayers throughout the day. Consider the A.C.T.S. model of prayer in light of this passage:

- Adoration: Adore God's goodness and grace revealed in this passage
- Confession: Confess your need for Christ in light of the text
- Thanksgiving: Thank God for His gospel and promises
- Supplication: Ask God to transform your heart to live in light of the Gospel
